Registration, Cancellation, and Refunds

If a check is not received within 10 business days of signing up for a day(s) or week(s), camper's spot will not be reserved. Unpaid balances must be paid before participants attend camp. If a balance remains unpaid for the remainder of the summer, we reserve the right to charge a card on file, and a campers' registration eligibility for the next summer session can be revoked. Regardless if a camper's parents/guardians are

If you do not submit your cancellation in writing by June 1, 2026, you will be responsible for all fees as space is limited. Safety Procedures

CAMP AWESOME® is a drop off only beach camp. Parents or authorized guardians listed on the Registration Form must check-in and check-out their children from camp (children will not be released from camp to someone who is not on the Registration Form as an Authorized Guardian for safety purposes). If you would like your child to be released to someone who is not on the Registration Form under Authorized Guardian, please update your Brightwheel account to include that person(s).

Brightwheel Application

For our check in/out procedures please download the Brightwheel app. This app is free and accessible through mobile (iOS & Android). It is also accessible via computers.

You can register with 2 easy steps:

1. Download app or go onto website
2. **Wait until you receive registration email or text from Brightwheel to create account**


***Note:** The Brightwheel invite will be sent closer to enrollment date.

Brightwheel application will allow parents/guardians to:

- check-in/out campers
- communicate with camp staff
- edit approved pick-ups

Once you create an account please log-in to review all information for accuracy. You will be able to update your camper information, as well as add/remove approved guardians. Reminder: if your camper will be bringing an EPI pen, please make sure to add on their account where it can be located in their backpack. Staff can not hold on to any type of medication.

***Note: Even though this app is in real-time, the kids are our #1 priority at Camp Awesome®, some updates may not always be on real-time.**



COVID-19 Protocols

Drop-Off/Pick-Up Procedures

- At pick-up/Drop-off parents or legal guardians must check in with a designated staff member. Campers will be safely escorted to the pick-up location. Any drop-off or pick-up outside of a family's registered times must be communicated with staff in advance.



Early Drop-Off/Late Pick-up Policy

Camp Awesome® regular program hours are 10:00 AM–4:00 PM. Extended care is available for Early Drop-off at 8:30am and Extended Pick-Up at 5:30pm. Families must be registered for extended care in advance. If a camper is dropped off or picked up outside their registered time, early or late fees will apply.

- Early fees begin 10 minutes before a camper's registered drop-off time (example: for regular hours, fees begin at 9:50 AM)
- Late fees begin 10 minutes after a camper's registered pick-up time (example: for regular hours, fees begin at 4:10 PM)

Early and late fees are charged per child. (Example: two children picked up late will incur a fee per child.) If a camper has not been picked up 15 minutes after their scheduled pick-up time and we have not received communication from a parent or guardian, Camp Awesome® will begin contacting authorized pick-up persons listed on the camper's account.

If a camper is not picked up by 6:00pm and no authorized pick-up can be reached, local authorities may be contacted in accordance with safety procedures.

Early and late fees must be paid promptly. Fees may be charged to the camper's account if not paid at drop-off or pick-up. Campers may be restricted from attending camp until outstanding fees are resolved.



SEPARATED OR DIVORCED PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Parents/guardians that are separated or divorced will need to provide copies of a signed court order if there are any restrictions regarding their child(ren). Without a signed court order, staff will be required to release the child(ren) to either parent/guardian or authorized adult(s) to pick up the child(ren). CAMP AWESOME® staff are not allowed to give out copies of documents and any related issues will be discussed with whomever picks up the participant that day. Any written material from CAMP AWESOME® will be provided to the individual that paid for the child(ren)'s registration. CAMP AWESOME® staff will immediately contact the Police Department for any violations of custody agreements on record.

CAMP AWESOME® Staff & Rules

CAMP AWESOME® Staff

CAMP AWESOME® staff have experience working with youth of all ages. The staff must pass a fingerprint and background check. All staff will go through CPR and First-Aid Training, in addition to other extensive trainings to better assist campers. CAMP AWESOME® offers volunteer opportunities. Volunteers will assist staff on leading, planning, and developing activities.

Special Needs/Disabilities

All children are welcome to attend camp. If your camper has any special needs (ie autism spectrum, disabilities.) please contact us prior to their first day of camp to ensure we can provide an awesome and safe experience. However, If extra attention is needed, parents may be required to provide this service with a certified aid and they will need to be with camper at all times throughout enrollment. When you arrive at camp please remind us at check-in about the conversation.

Things We Should Know

If there is anything else you feel we should be aware of in regard to your camper please do not hesitate to let us know at check-in.

Camper Rules

Parents, please discuss the following Camp Rules with your child before the beginning of camp.

- Campers must listen to directions from staff.
- Campers must stay in assigned areas and may not go to the water or bathrooms without supervision.
- No physical fighting or causing harm to others.
- Campers must keep their hands/feet to themselves.
- No use of profanity or inappropriate language or behavior.
- Campers must respect camp property and other campers' property (no stealing).
- Respect your environment by throwing out all trash, and returning equipment to its proper place after use.
- Always follow the rule of treating others as you wish to be treated.

***Remember you are at camp to have fun, play, and have an awesome time while making new friends, trying new activities, and building positive self-esteem in a safe environment.**

MANDATED REPORTERS

CAMP AWESOME® staff are mandated reporters by law. If there are any suspected cases of child abuse or neglect, the staff will report directly to the appropriate authorities for investigation.

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Camper Expectations

CAMP AWESOME® is designed for campers ages 4-13. In order to have an AWESOME® experience, campers need to have some level of self-sufficiency. **All campers must be fully potty-trained and able to speak up for their needs.** While staff will be closely supervising the children, **campers** need to be able to communicate with staff if they need to use the restroom, if they're hungry, thirsty, don't feel well, lost an item, etc. Staff will periodically ask campers if they need to use the restroom or need to get water throughout the day; if your camper does not speak up, we can't help them.

Campers also need to recognize when it is lunch time. Staff will announce lunch time, and at this time, campers are directed to find a spot in the shade and eat their lunch. While staff will make every effort to ensure campers have their lunch and are eating, **campers** are ultimately responsible for eating their lunch. If campers do not have a lunch, get sand in their lunch, etc., campers need to tell a staff.

If you think your camper may struggle with the above issues, please let us know ahead of time so we can work with you and your camper to make sure they feel comfortable communicating with our staff.

Camper Behavior Policy

CAMP AWESOME® reserves the right to dismiss any camper for inappropriate or unsafe behavior. The Camp will always make an effort to discuss and resolve any issues with a camper with their parent(s) or guardian(s). If a problem persists and cannot be corrected, the decision to dismiss a camper will be made by the Camp Director in consultation with staff. No refunds will be given for children who are dismissed from camp due to disciplinary reasons.

Campers may be given a warning first depending on the severity of their behavior.

The second time, if behavior persists, camper(s) will be removed from AWESOME® activities for 5-10 minutes.

If the behavior persists after multiple warnings, the camper will be given a consequence form which will need to be taken home and signed by parent or guardian to return to camp.

If a camper receives more than three consequence forms; or fewer depending on the severity of infractions, they may be suspended from camp. The length of the suspension is based on the severity of the offense. If this occurs, the camper's parents or guardians will be notified of the issue. If the camper is allowed to return to the program, the camper will be placed on probation for the remainder of the summer. If there are any further incidents with the camper, they may be expelled from CAMP AWESOME®.

***Note: All consequences depend on the severity of the offense. A camper can be immediately suspended or permanently expelled from CAMP AWESOME® upon their first offense. Physical assault, threats, fighting, possession of any item that may injure or harm anyone, theft, and vandalism will not be tolerated. Refunds will not be given for suspensions or expulsions.**

What To Pack, What Not To Pack & Social Media

What To Pack

Each camper is so special and unique and as a parent you know them best. Working together, we can make sure your camper has a successful time with us!

CAMPERS SHOULD BRING:

- **LUNCH**
- **PLENTY OF SNACKS**
- **WATER**

Food should be kept in a lunch bag to keep seagulls out. We take a snack break throughout the day, so please pack plenty of snacks. It is the campers responsibility to bring their own lunch, plenty of snacks and water. We do not provide snacks to campers during the camp day with the exception of an occasional camp-wide award.



Please bring plenty of water since campers will be outdoors in the sun; water will be needed to keep hydrated. There are drinking fountains available, however we recommend campers bring their own water.

It is required for campers to bring their CAMP AWESOME® rash-guard. Footwear that is appropriate for the beach such as **CROCS, SANDALS or Flip Flops**. Campers need to **bring some form of footwear for an active schedule and hot sand**.

We encourage campers to stay in their swimwear the entire day. Changing is often not feasible given the number of campers and the time it takes to change. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that campers do not change and dry off in their swimwear.

Campers should bring a beach towel since they will be sitting on the sand and because they might need one to dry off when they go in the water.

SUN BLOCK is crucial and should be **brought to camp everyday**. Please be sure to apply sunscreen before your camper arrives to the beach. If your camper has fair skin we recommend using Zinc based products and wearing a hat. You can also send them with long sleeve rash guards and thin pants to protect their legs. We spend time in the shade and reapply sunscreen throughout the day, but we find that campers who begin the days with a strong base have better protection from the sun. Please note: Campers are responsible to put on sunscreen, however if they have trouble putting on sunscreen they need to inform staff. Staff may help campers put on sunblock if needed; if you do not want us to put sun block on your child please inform the camp director; if this is the case your child will be responsible for putting on his/her own sun block. CAMP AWESOME® is not responsible for a child getting sun burned. CAMP AWESOME® will have the campers put on sun block continuously throughout the day. If a camper refuses to put on sun block, it will be documented and the parent(s) or guardian(s) will be notified.



What To Pack Continued...

Campers should bring a backpack where they can store all their belongings. CAMP AWESOME® is not responsible for anything that is damaged, lost, or stolen. It is the camper's responsibility to take care of their belongings.

***Camp rash-guard will be given the first day child attends CAMP AWESOME®. Once camp rash-guard has been received it is required campers wear rash-guard everyday they attend camp.**



What To Bring Everyday Check-List

1. Lunch, plenty of snacks in bag or lunch box, and water.
2. **SUNSCREEN REQUIRED** (spray preferred)
3. **CAMP AWESOME® Rash-Guard REQUIRED** (Rash-Guard will be distributed first day child attends camp).
4. Hat/Cap is highly recommended
5. Towel
6. Reusable water bottle
7. Beach shoes, sandals or flip flops (appropriate footwear)
8. Swim Wear (Swimsuit, Swim Trunks)
9. Beach umbrella (optional)
10. Bodyboard (optional)

***Remember: each child is responsible for their own items. Labeling can assist with identifying your child's items.**

***Note: Parents or legal guardians must notify staff at check-in of any allergies or medications. Any medication sent with a camper should be clearly labeled. Camp Awesome® staff do not administer medication, and campers must be able to self-administer when appropriate.**

What Not To Pack

To help ensure a safe, inclusive, and enjoyable camp experience for all campers, please review the following guidelines:

- **No sodas, energy drinks, or caffeinated beverages** are permitted. Water, flavored water, sports drinks, and juice are allowed.
- **Personal electronics** (including cell phones, tablets, smartwatches with calling features, handheld gaming devices, and music players) are not permitted during camp activities. If a parent chooses to send a cellphone with their child, it must remain stored in the camper's backpack at all times. **Camp Awesome® is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.**
- **Food sharing is not allowed** due to food allergies and safety concerns (including but not limited to peanuts, dairy, and seafood).
- **Do not send expensive items or items of sentimental value**, as they may be lost or damaged during camp activities.
- **Wheeled items** are not permitted, including bicycles, scooters, skateboards, hoverboards, rollerblades, or shoes with wheels.
- **Weapons or weapon-like items** (real or toy), including fake weapons or objects that could cause physical or emotional harm, are strictly prohibited.
- **Snacks requiring heating or cooking** are not allowed, as there are no facilities available at the beach.
- **Trading cards, collectible toys, or small game items** (such as Pokémon, Yu-Gi-Oh, Magic cards, Beyblades, Legos, etc.) are not permitted, as they are easily lost, damaged, or cause disputes among campers.

Pizza Fridays

Every Friday we will be having pizza for lunch! If you are interested in having your camper join please send them with \$5. Unfortunately, this year we will not be providing drinks or additional snacks. Please send your camper with anything extra you think they may need.

Ice Cream Truck

CAMP AWESOME® will normally be visited by an Ice Cream Truck daily. The schedule is not readily available since they stop by the area randomly. If you would like to send your camper with cash (\$2-\$3) to purchase an **optional** treat from the truck you may do so. Money must be in a sealed bag to prevent loss and may only be shared among household members. **Please be aware we can not hold on to cash for the campers and they need to be responsible for it themselves.**

Illness & Emergency Procedures

Illness

If your child is ill, please keep him/her at home for the day. We ask for your consideration for the health of all of our campers and staff. If a child is injured or becomes ill during the camp day, parent(s) or guardian(s) will be notified. If the illness or injury is significant to the extent that your child can no longer participate in camp activities, you will be notified immediately and asked to pick up your child.

In the unlikely event that an injury or illness requires emergency care, you will be notified immediately. The supervisor may have to contact 911 or lifeguards, and paramedics may have to transport your child with accompanying staff member to an emergency care facility. Parents or the designated guardian will be responsible for any medical fees incurred.

If your child receives a minor injury, such as a scraped elbow, staff will administer basic First Aid. Depending on the severity of incident staff will inform parent/guardian over phone, Brightwheel app or during pick-up. However, during pick-up it is the parents/guardians responsibility to ask staff about any questions or concerns they may have. If child is picked-up too quickly by parent/guardian staff may not have a chance to discuss these items.

We strongly encourage you to administer any regular medication your child takes at home. Staff will NOT administer any medication. The child, parent/guardian, or caregiver designated by the parent/guardian will be responsible for administering any medications at the appropriate time. Staff will try to remind the child of scheduled medication, but staff or CAMP AWESOME® are NOT responsible for ensuring medication is taken. Staff will not carry medication; that is the responsibility of the child, parent/guardian, or caregiver.

If your camper requires an EPI Pen please mark their bag clearly and indicate where the medication is located in case of emergency. Our staff changes daily so please remember to remind staff at drop-off. *Reminder: staff cannot administer medication.

In the case of severe weather, CAMP AWESOME® reserves the right to cancel any activities that may endanger campers.

CAMP AWESOME® provides campers with the philosophy FREEDOM OF CHOICE! CAMP AWESOME® provides multiple activities to allow campers to choose the activities they would like to participate in. This not only provides campers with an awesome experience, but it gives them the FREEDOM to choose for themselves the activities they enjoy participating in. CAMP AWESOME® believes in campers being innovative and creative.

CAMP AWESOME® takes bullying seriously but also aims to build self-confidence, build friendships, develop social skills and creating awesome experiences through camper's own self reliance. We encourage campers to try to deal with certain situations as best as they can with our help, guidance and supervision.






